Find Your Voice

All students are expected to be either an entry level or developing musician (Levels 3 or 4) by the end of the Autumn term.

A = achieved all of the musical skills in the level, and working partly in the level above

B = achieved at least half of the musical skills in the level

C = achieved some of the musical skills in the level

Type of musician	Equivalent NC Level	You can:
Entry Level	3	<p>sing in tune with expression</p> <p>recognise how musical elements (timbre, texture, dynamics, silence, duration, tempo and pitch) are combined and used expressively</p> <p>improve your work, talking about the effect you wanted</p>
Developing	4	<p>suggest ideas and improvements to your own and other students' work</p> <p>use musical language, including Italian terms</p> <p>listen when practising and performing, and improve your timing</p>
Competent	5	<p>lead your group, or understand what your role is in the group (be it a soloist or rhythmic support)</p> <p>understand how music is affected by venue, occasion</p>
