Year 11 Art and Design Help Sheet

The course assessment is weighted 60% portfolio and 40% exam. From August to December students work on a personal portfolio. From January onwards students will create work in preparation for the practical exam.

Students in year 11 should spend time at home

- -working on drawings and paintings
- -taking photographs that are relevant to their theme
- -annotating their sketchbook with reference to visual artists that they have researched.
- -working in a range of media including oil pastel, paint, pen, coloured pencil and charcoal
- -researching visual artists online to inspire them
